CASE

A large dairy plant in Asia wanted to expand its continuous improvement activities and improve quality in all plant loss areas. The dairy undertook a full TPM, which was three-year process and involved all employees and equipment. We helped the customer establish relevant KPI's and an efficient continuous improvement methodology. This was implemented by training and coaching different teams across the customer's organisation.

The accumulated direct savings, not counting benefits from additional capacity, between 2014 and 2016 totalled more than €9 million. Overall Equipment Effectiveness increased from 70% to 80% over three years, and the high level is sustained thanks to the implemented routines. Additionally, the customer's productivity increased by 230%.
